3b construction successfully delivered a new marine engineering workshop at Stornoway Port, contributing to the wider £12 million regeneration of the Newton Basin and Goat Island areas.

The project involved the construction of a modern marine engineering facility incorporating two covered boat repair bays, designed to support both long-term and short-term vessel maintenance. The development also included a dedicated external wash-down area linked to the new boat hoist, together with associated infrastructure to enhance the port's marine servicing capabilities.

Designed to support both the commercial and leisure marine sectors, the new facilities provide opportunities for local businesses to expand operations, create skilled employment, and make greater use of the port's infrastructure. Delivered within a live operational environment, the project demonstrates 3b construction's expertise in delivering complex marine and industrial developments while maintaining the highest standards of quality, safety, and programme management.
